

C-17 Maintenance Facility, Aircraft Apron and Associated Infrastructure Project, RAAF Base Amberley

Industry Brief

Existing heavy aircraft maintenance facilities at RAAF Base Amberley including the shared hangar and workshops have been found to have significant shortfalls when required to support both the C-17A and KC-30A aircraft.

The requirements to support the additional C-17A aircraft have provided the basis for the proposed maintenance facility and the additional aircraft apron for this project.

CPB Contractors has been appointed the Managing Contractor for the project with an expected approval in August/September 2016.

The first phase of construction of the project is expected to commence December 2016 with completion programmed for September 2018.

Opportunity exists to tender expressions of interest for a number of trade packages for the project. These trade packages cover a diverse range of trades from Civil Works, Aircraft Pavements, Building Works, Aircraft Docking and other specific aircraft support infrastructure such as hydrant refueling and airfield lighting.

The Department of State Development SEQ West will host an information session attended by CPB Contractors representative/s to provide an overview of the project, general timings, tender process, and how to register an Expression of Interest.
